

the Visitor Center bring back poignant memories as well as providing new insight into the events and the heroes of Flight 93. Dedicated on 9/9/2018 is "The Tower of Voices," a 93-foot tall tower housing 40 large windchimes. As the breezes blow visitors will hear "the voices of Flight 93." Each tour member receives a commemorative magnet "Remember the Heroes of Flight 93

Visit the Flight 93 Memorial Chapel, which was dedicated on the first anniversary of 9/11 to honor God and the memory of the 40 heroes of Flight 93.
