Pay your respects at the Flight 93 National Memorial including both the Memorial Plaza with the Wall of Names of the Heroes of Flight 93 and the Visitor Center, dedicated on Sept 10, 2015. The exhibits in the Visitor Center bring back poignant memories as well as providing new insight into the events and the heroes of Flight 93. Dedicated on 9/9/2018 is "The Tower of Voices," a 93-foot tall tower housing 40 large windchimes. As the breezes, blow

visitors will hear "the voices of Flight 93." Each tour member receives a commemorative magnet "Remember the Heroes of Flight 93."

Visit the Flight 93 Memorial Chapel, which was dedicated on the first anniversary of 9/11 to honor God and the memory of the 40 heroes of Flight 93.
